

YEAR 10 ADOLESCENT REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH TALK FACILITATED BY SCHOOL NURSE MS. OWUOR

On the 21st of February, 2024, the year 10 students were given a talk on Adolescent Reproductive Health with an aim of ensuring adolescents navigate the adolescence stage safely, with confidence, and with the best prospects for a healthy and productive life.

The talk delved into various changes that occur during adolescence including physical, biological, cognitive and social aspects. Understanding these changes is crucial for a holistic approach to reproductive Health. Focusing on Adolescent Reproductive Health (ARH) as well ensures the adolescents are well prepared with safety measures to conquer major health risks such as HIV/AIDS, teenage pregnancies, drug and substance use and other Health consequences.

We focused on the critical aspects of ARH such as peer pressure/ peer influence, drug and substance abuse, Sexually Transmitted Infections or Diseases (STIs/STDs), HIV/AIDS and adolescent pregnancy and their associated consequences. Emphasis was then placed on the importance of self-awareness, good decision making skills, assertiveness and open communication regarding reproductive health as key components of navigating adolescence successfully.

With the well-targeted talk, the students have been empowered with skills necessary for a healthy transition through adolescence.




On 22th February, our under 13 boys basketball team performed exceptionally well during their match against Woodcreek International School but they were overwhelmed to 12-21 as the final score.
