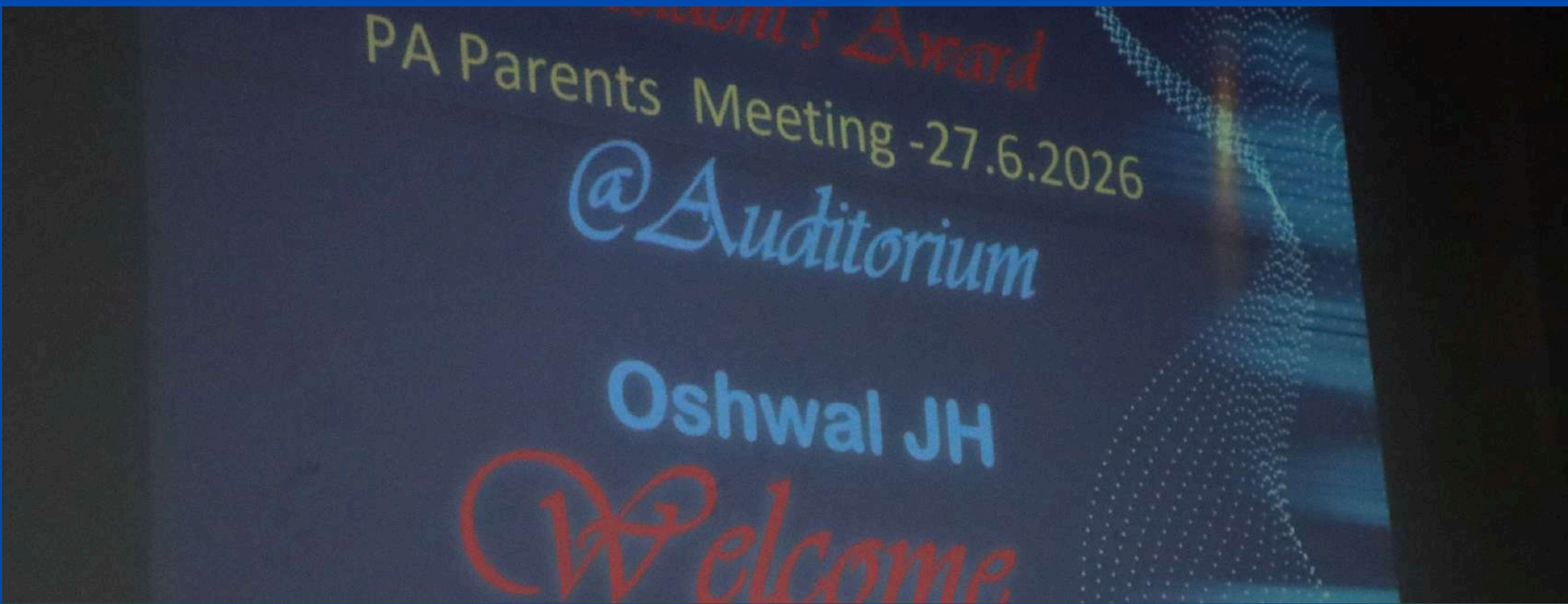

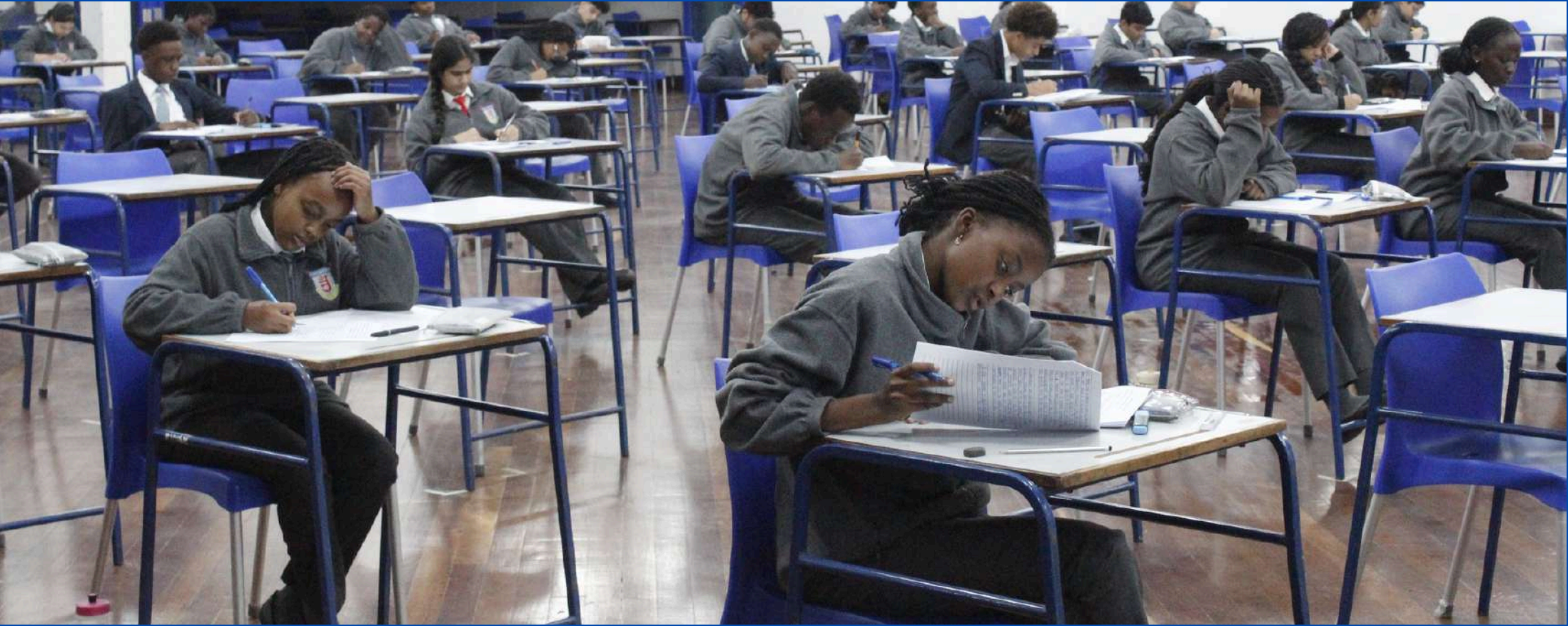
PRESIDENT'S AWARD PARENTS' MEETING

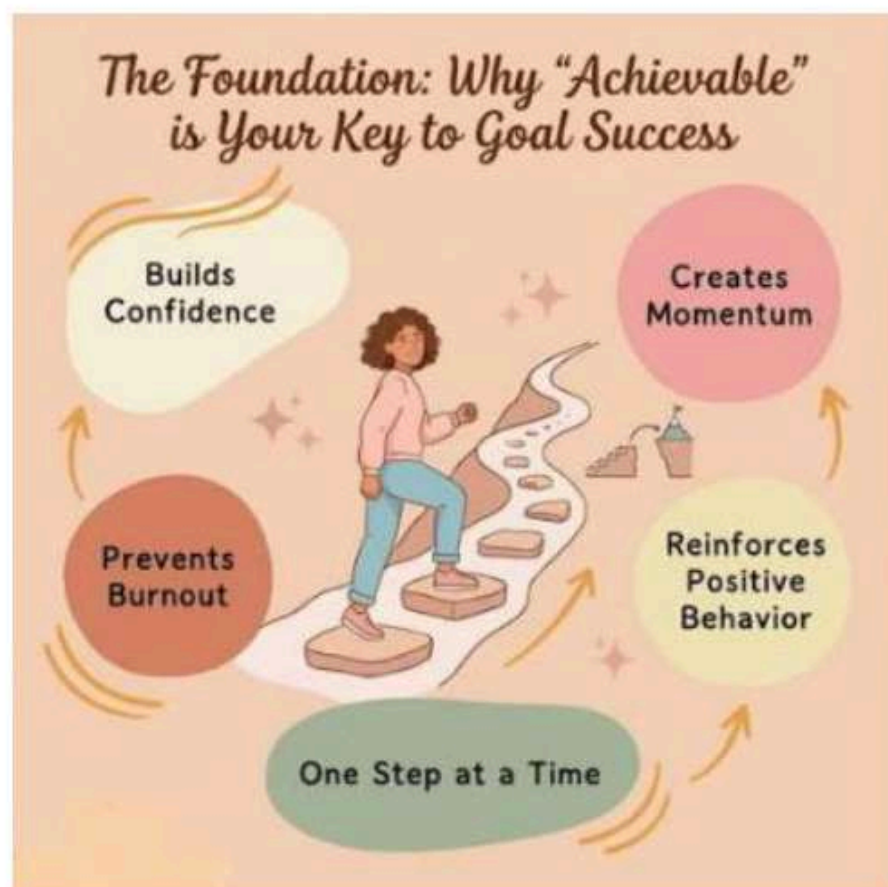
Ready for New Adventures

Activity for Reflection

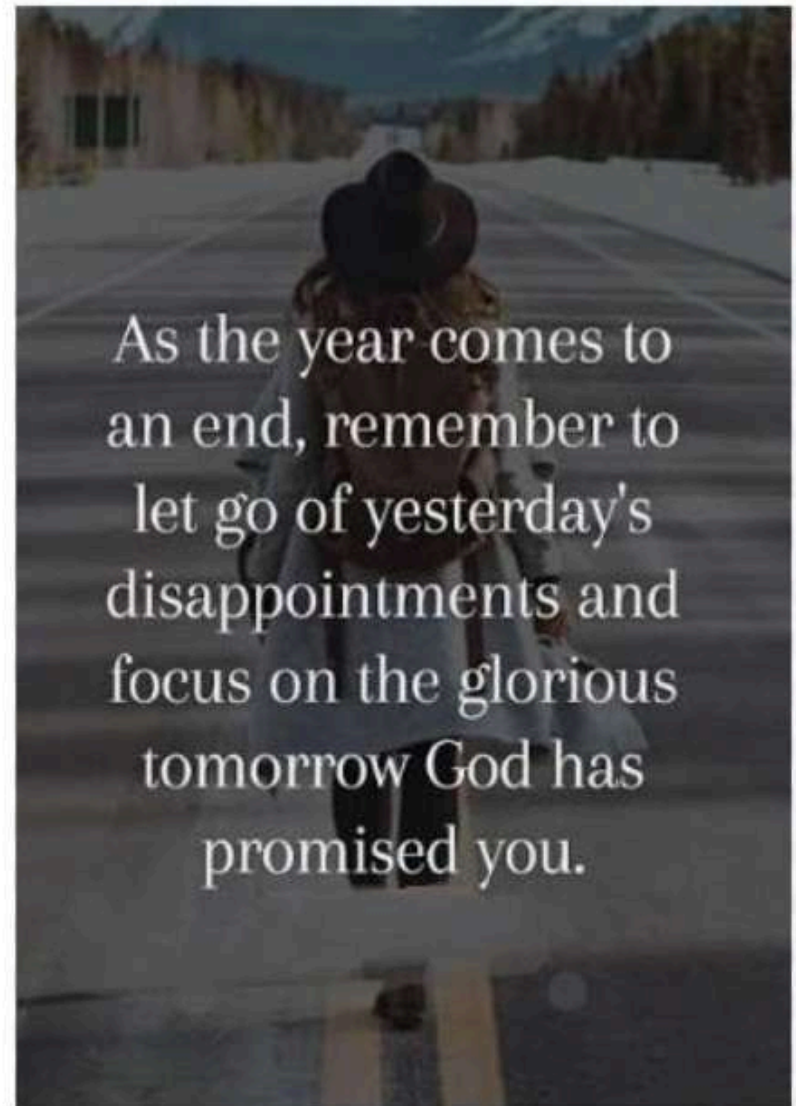

The villagers agreed. They started digging together. But after a few days, they got tired and gave up.

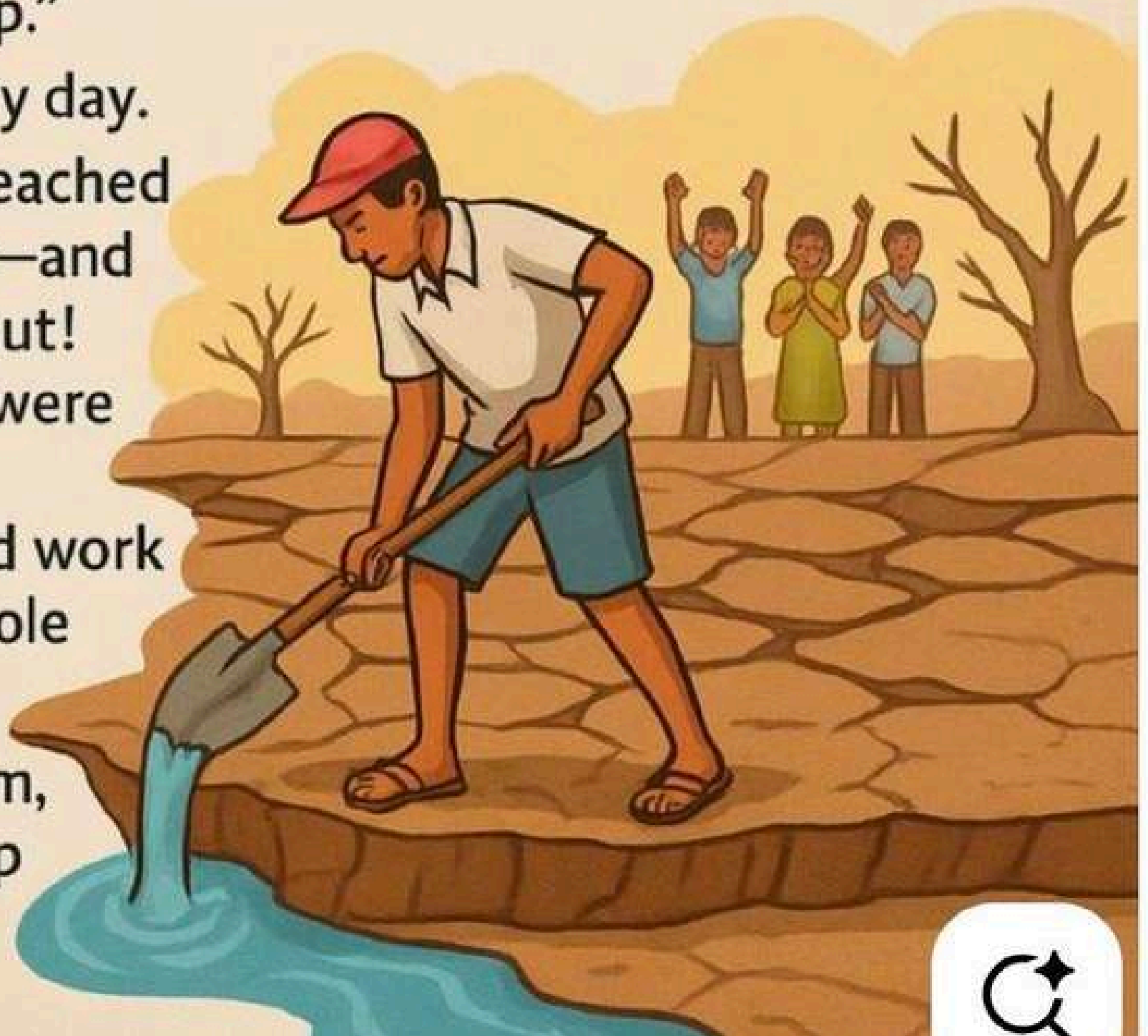
Rodney didn't stop. He said, "I believe we'll find water. I won't give up."

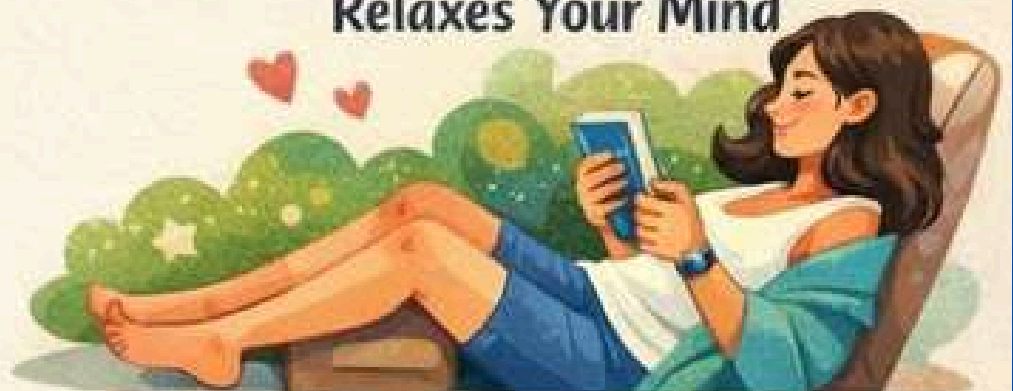
